11.0 New Business

- 11.1 Discussion and possible motion regarding OSLAD Grant at Spring Bluff Forest Preserve Executive Director Kovach summarized a \$263,700 OSLAD grant awarded for a trail and wildlife observation platform at Spring Bluff Forest Preserve. In January 2015 the District signed the grant agreement committing to match funds and returned it to IDNR to be countersigned, however before being fully executed the State suspended the grant. The District then removed the project from the funded project list in the CIP. In August 2016, IDNR sent the fully executed grant agreement and notification that the State authorized an advance payment of 50% of the grant award and the project must be completed by August 2018. The District immediately notified IDNR that the project was removed from the budget. After talking with IDNR, the District has three options, which Mr. Kovach explained: 1) Accept the grant, which would require no formal Board action; 2) Reject the grant immediately to avoid debarment for two years from state grants, which would require Board approval; or 3) delay a decision until the next budget process, requiring no Board action now. Following discussion and comments from President Maine, it was the consensus of the Board to accept the grant (Option 1), place the project back on the CIP funded project list during the next budget process, and staff will look for ways to reduce the scope of the project to keep the costs down.
- 11.2 **Report on Recent County-wide Attitude and Interest Study Jeff Andreasen, aQity Research**Mr. Andreasen appeared before the Board with a PowerPoint presentation summarizing the results and key findings of a County-wide Attitude and Interest Survey of Lake County residents conducted April 29 through May 26, 2016. The study showed that residents continue to hold the Forest Preserves in high esteem.
- **12.0** <u>Petitions, Correspondence and Reports</u> Commissioner Taylor reported on Environmental Education, Public Affairs and Cultural Resources events and announcements.
