RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of a Resolution awarding a Contract for 2018 Tree and Shrub Purchases for Multiple Forest Preserves to Majestic Oaks Nursery, Spring Grove, Illinois, in the Contract Price of \$52,339.08.

### STRATEGIC DIRECTION SUPPORTED: Conservation

FINANCIAL DATA: District-wide Reforestation was approved as part of the adopted FY 2017/2018 Capital Improvement Plan in the amount of \$100,000.00. This portion of the program was estimated at \$65,300.00. The vendor with bids under \$25,000.00 that does not require Committee and Board will be awarded a contract totaling \$9,796.75, and combined with this proposed contract total \$62,135.83, which will be charged to the Development Levy Fund (20104100-803200-60008) in the amount of \$48,659.56 and the Natural Resource Grant Fund (69644100-803200-56013) in the amount of \$13,476.27.

BACKGROUND: The District implements the Reforestation Program in order to restore historically altered or degraded lands to natural forest, woodland, and savanna communities, reduce habitat fragmentation, restore woodland connectivity, enhance wildlife habitat, and improve the aesthetic quality of the preserves. In March of 2017, the District was awarded grant funding from the U.S. Forest Service, as part of the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative, which entails the planting of native trees / shrubs as one of the grant-funded activities. A portion of this earmarked funding will support the restoration tree-planting activities at Lyons Woods Forest Preserve. In the fall of 2018, a total of 3,084 native trees and shrubs will be installed across approximately 163 acres at Grassy Lake (Hurd parcel), Lyons Woods (US Forest Service Grant), Captain Daniel Wright Woods (Lloyd's Woods), Rollins Savanna, Van Patten Woods, Lakewood and Ray Lake Forest Preserves.

The project was advertised on November 17, 2017 and two bids were received. A summary of the bids received is listed below:

Materials were bid on a unit price per species. Staff has awarded a contract to Possibility Place Nursery, whose total bid is less than \$25,000.00. Staff recommends that Majestic Oaks Nursery be awarded a contract as the lowest responsible bidder for the species for which it was the low bidder. Tree and shrubs are ordered now for anticipated planting to begin in September, 2018 and be completed by October, 2018.

WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") has advertised in The Lake County News Sun for sealed bids to purchase native trees and shrubs for 2018 Reforestation Projects at multiple preserves (the "Products"); and

WHEREAS, all sealed bids were received and opened by the District at its General Offices, 1899 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois on December 12, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.; and
