



## **Fort Sheridan – Master Plan Advisory Committee Meeting**

*December 2, 2009*

The Fort Sheridan Forest Preserve Master Plan Advisory Committee began at its first meeting December 2 to work towards reaching a consensus on future public uses for the [Fort Sheridan Forest Preserve](#).

The committee's purpose is to present a recommendation on preferred public uses at the preserve to the Forest Preserve Board. Committee members include representatives from neighboring cities and park districts, Forest Preserve Commissioners from those communities, the Fort Sheridan Homeowners Association, the U.S. Department of the Army and the 10th District Congressional office.

At the session, committee members expressed divergent visions for the preserve. Options discussed included an 18-hole golf course, a blended golf course and preserve alternative, a traditional forest preserve, and an alternative to land bank the site for three to five years and then reassess market and economic changes. The committee members agreed that they represent varying interests and decided to bring in an impartial facilitator to conduct its future meetings.
