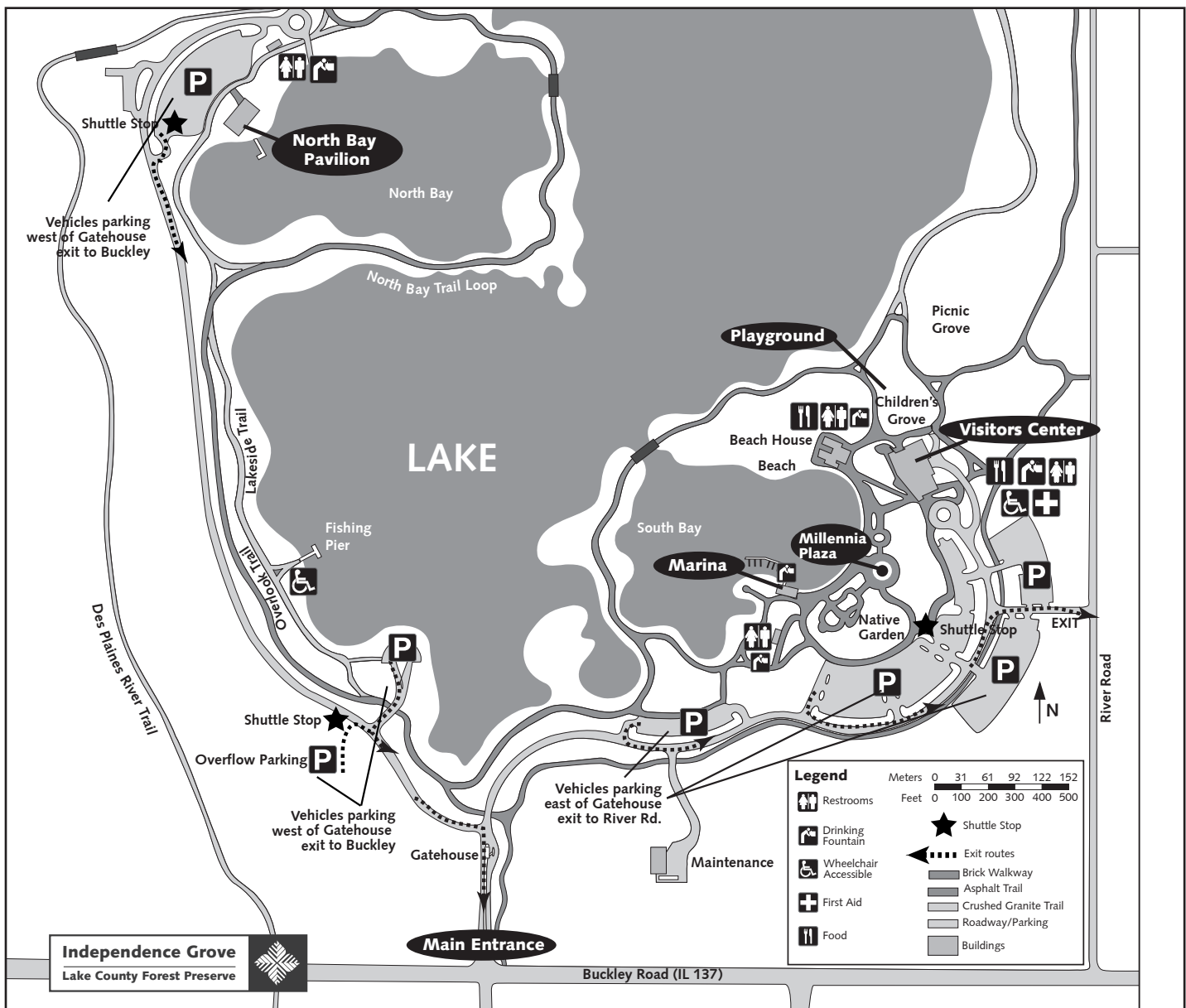

New in 2010

Capacity closure: Concert admittance will be cut off when preserve parking spaces are full. Please car pool if possible so that more people can enjoy the concert. For your safety and neighbor courtesy please, only park in the preserve. To learn if admission is closed, call the Visitors Center, 847-968-3499.

Exit routing: Cars parked on the east side of the preserve must exit at River Rd. and will only be allowed to turn north onto River Rd., where the first intersection is Guerin Rd. Cars parked on the west side of the preserve must exit onto Buckley Rd. and will only be allowed to turn west onto Buckley Rd., where the first intersection is Milwaukee Ave.
