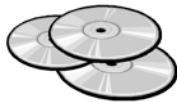
Kinds of Archaeology

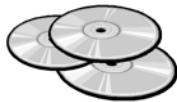
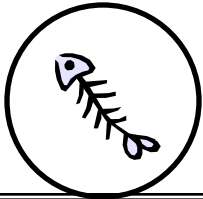
