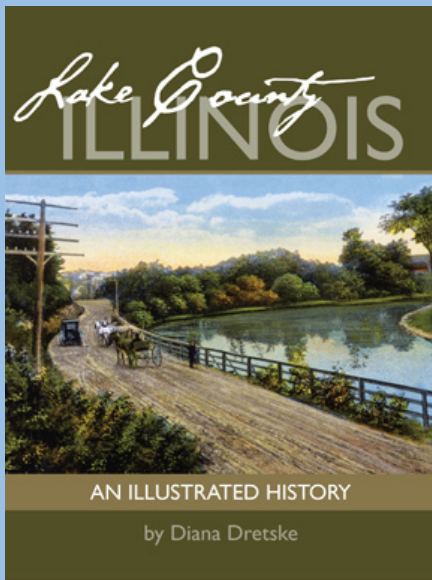


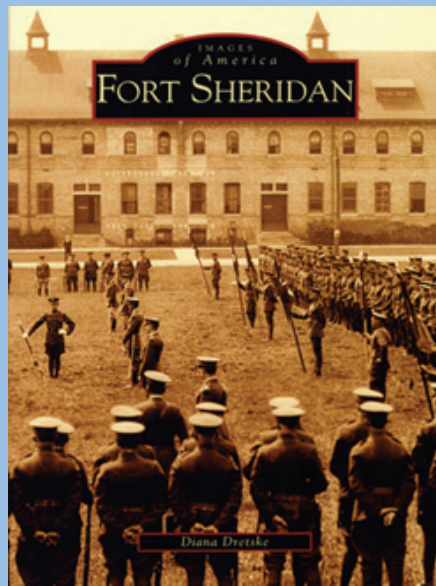

By Diana Dretske

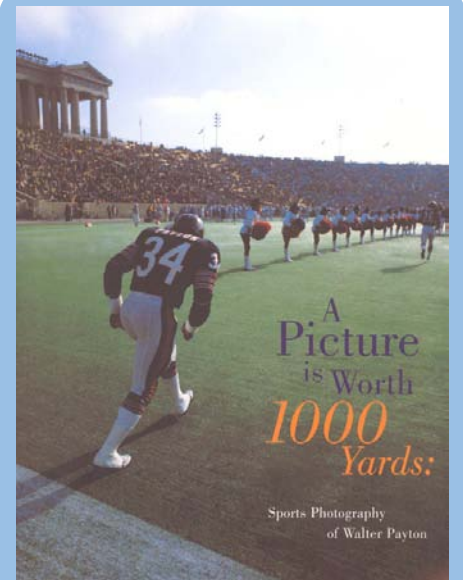
