# Tuesday: HOPPERS and JUMPERS in the grass

Many animals hop and jump. We'll try to catch a few of them to get a closer look. This day features insect netting in tall grasses and prairies. **Wear long pants and closed-toe shoes.** No Crocs, please.



# Wednesday: What's that SWIMMING?

We will use a dip net to capture and observe a few animals that swim, and learn how they move in water. Wear clothes and closed-toe shoes with heel straps that can get wet and muddy. No Crocs, please.



# Thursday: CRAWLERS and WALKERS in the forest

Explore the forest for animals that move a lot like you. Wear a lightweight, long-sleeved shirt and pants, and bring insect repellent.



# Friday: SLITHERING along

Get low and look carefully to find animals that move without legs.
