BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE DISTRICT –REGULAR NOVEMBER MEETING MINUTES NOVEMBER 15, 2023

The Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District met on Wednesday, November 15, 2023 at the District's General Offices, 1899 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois.

1.0 Call to Order – President Angelo Kyle called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

President Kyle announced that notices were received from Commissioners Michael Danforth and Marah Altenberg requesting to attend the meeting electronically due to employment; from Commissioner Ann Maine due to a family emergency, and from Commissioner Paul Frank for a non-stated qualifying reason.
