# BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE DISTRICT - REGULAR MARCH MEETING MINUTES MARCH 12, 2019

The Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District met on Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at the County Building, 10<sup>th</sup> Floor, 18 N. County Street, Waukegan, Illinois.

- **1.0** Call to Order President Angelo Kyle called the meeting to order at 11:07 a.m.
- **2.0** Roll Call of Commissioners Secretary Gragnani called the roll and 15 Commissioners answered present: Barr, Carlson, Clark, Cunningham, Danforth, Durkin, Hewitt, Kyle, Martini, Pedersen, Rummel, Simpson, Vealitzek, Wasik, and Wilke. - 9.1 Ordinance Amending the 10-Year Capital Improvement Plan and Fiscal Year 2018/19 Budget Motion by Commissioner Wilke, second by Commissioner Simpson to Approve an Ordinance Amending the 10-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and the Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Budget.

Public comment was given:

- Grant Benjamin, Ingleside; representing Squaw Creek Clean Water Alliance; spoke in favor of adding the Grant Woods-Long Lake shoreline stabilization project to the District's CIP.
- Leon LeJeunesse, Grayslake; read a statement from the Sierra Club asking the Board to include the Grant Woods-Long Lake shoreline stabilization project in the CIP.
- Gloria Charland, Ingleside; representing Long Lake Improvement and Sanitation Association; asked the Board to support the Grant Woods-Long Lake shoreline stabilization project.
- Susan Pribyl, Ingleside; spoke in favor of approving the amended CIP as recommended by staff and the Finance Committee including the Grant Woods-Long Lake shoreline stabilization project.

Motion by Commissioner Rummel, second by Commissioner Cunningham to amend the Ordinance in the third Whereas clause by removing the following two projects under the column entitled "Project Description" and by removing the following increases under the column entitled "Budget Impact Increase/(Decrease)": (1) General Offices – Front Entry Safety Bollards for \$25,000 and (2) Grant Woods-Long Lake Shoreline Stabilization for \$400,000.

Commissioner Paxton left the meeting at 11:37 a.m.

A comment period by Commissioners ensued and Executive Director Kovach explained that the budget process for 2020 will begin at the June 3 joint committee meeting, at which time staff will have a more accurate financial picture for CIP planning.
