Amphibian Scavenger Hunt

Enjoy a walk around your yard or neighborhood while searching for amphibians (and the things they need).

Small ponds or pools of water
Dead logs or woodpiles
Dead leaves on the ground from last year
Western Chorus frog (may be calling—listen for a sound that sounds like you are running your fingernail along the teeth of a comb)
Food for amphibians: spiders, slugs, worms, beetles
American toad (may be calling—listen for a high-pitched trilling noise coming from a pond or marsh on warm spring days)
