Wear a Mask

Shop with Your Eyes

Browse the gift shop with your eyes. If you are interested in purchasing a product, gloves are available at the front desk. We will only be taking credit cards as payment.

Go with the Flow

Follow the one-way route through the Museum to ensure social distancing. Please respect any gallery closures.

Watch the Clock

At the end of your visit, please exit promptly so staff has enough time to clean before the next visitor time slot.

Declare that you are not experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19.
