Outdoor Exploration Activity & How You Can Help the Blanding's Turtle

- ❖ Explore Forest Preserves with wetlands, ponds, lakes and rivers. If you see any turtles, take a picture and email it to us at AskAnEducator@LCFPD.org to be identified—or post it to our LCFPD Facebook page.
 - Look for turtles basking in the sun on logs or large rocks. Count how many turtles you see.
 - How many are big turtles and how many are small turtles?
 - What colors do you see on the turtles?
- ❖ Bring a trash bag and gloves to clean up any litter along the shoreline.
- Conserve water. Don't use pesticides or chemicals on your lawn.
- Support wetland restoration and conservation. Volunteer to remove invasive species.
- ❖ Drive carefully near wetlands. Check for turtles under your car before driving away.
- Do not bring wild animals inside as pets. Don't feed wildlife or leave pet food unattended outdoors as it may attract predators of Blanding's turtles.
