## Monday: Drawing

Delve into the wonderful world of art by creating 2D projects. Practice a variety of drawing skills and become a sketch artist like famous Lake County artist Franklin McMahon. Campers will make projects centered on drawing such as creating cartoons, illustrating books, and sketching still life.



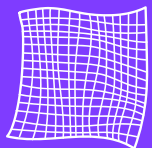
## Tuesday: Painting

Put on your smocks and take out your brushes! Today's activities will revolve around using different paints such as acrylic and watercolor. We will take a closer look at paintings done by local artist Reima Ratti.



## Wednesday: Sculpting

Play with clay and use sculpting tools to create 3D works of art. Campers will make sculptures, pinch pots, and more. We will spend time in the Dunn Museum's galleries looking at how the *Dryptosaurus* dinosaur was created, plus other famous examples of sculpture from Lake County.



## Thursday: Mixed Media

How many materials can you use? Campers will explore mixed media art with an assortment of materials, from fabric to wood. We will also examine folk art by studying local artists and recreating their work.



## Friday: Prints and Photography

Today we will try many printing methods, such as monotype, etching, and woodcarving. Campers will also learn about photography and examine photos taken by historian Bess Bower Dunn. We'll wrap up the camp by putting the best works of art on display for all to see.
