RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of a Resolution awarding a Contract for the Repositioning of Existing Fire Suppression System at the District General Offices to United States Alliance Fire Protection, Inc., Lake Forest, Illinois, in the Contract Price amount of \$29,400.00.

FINANCIAL DATA: This expenditure was approved as part of the adopted FY 2015/16 Budget to provide for facility and infrastructure improvements. The cost of \$29,400.00 will be charged to account 11104100-803100-61811.

BACKGROUND: In preparation for moving the Lake County Discovery Museum's collection to the General Office, the District solicited bids for the Repositioning of the Existing Fire Suppression System. Two bidders responded by the May 25, 2016, bid opening deadline. They were:

TO UNITED STATES ALLIANCE FIRE PROTECTION, INC.**

WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") has advertised in The News Sun for sealed bids for the Repositioning of Existing Fire Suppression System at the District General Offices (the "Work"); and

WHEREAS, all sealed bids were received and opened by the District at its General Offices, 1899 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois on May 25, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, bids were received in the following amounts from the following bidders:

WHEREAS, the District's staff, the Purchasing Manager, the Director of Operational Facilities, and the Finance and Administrative Committee have reviewed the bids and recommend that the Board of Commissioners find United States Alliance Fire Protection, Inc., to be the lowest responsible bidder and award a contract for the Work to United States Alliance Fire Protection, Inc. (the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that United States Alliance Fire Protection, Inc., is the lowest responsible bidder for the Work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois THAT:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are incorporated as a part of this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Award of Contract. The bid submitted by United States Alliance Fire Protection, Inc., in the amount of \$29,400.00 (the "Contract Price") is hereby accepted and a Contract for the Work is hereby awarded to United States Alliance Fire Protection, Inc.

Section 3. Execution of Contract. The Executive Director of the District is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Contract for the Work in the amount of the Contract Price.

Section 4. Payments. The District Treasurer shall make payments under the Contract only pursuant to and in accordance with the Contract terms.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
