## **SUBJECT:** LCDOT - 14<sup>th</sup> Street Improvements at Greenbelt Forest Preserve

**<u>REQUEST</u>**: Provide policy direction regarding a request from the Lake County Division of Transportation to consider the exchange of District property and temporary easements for road improvements and a shared-use path along 14<sup>th</sup> Street at Greenbelt Forest Preserve, and to authorize negotiation of an intergovernmental agreement between the LCDOT and the District.

**BACKGROUND:** The Lake County Division of Transportation (LCDOT) is in the process of preparing preliminary Phase I design plans for future improvements to 14<sup>th</sup> Street between Illinois Route 131 (Green Bay Road) and Jackson Street which will include widening the existing road through North Chicago and Waukegan and a reconstruction of the Dugdale Road intersection as a roundabout. As part of the planned improvements, LCDOT will construct a 10-foot wide shared-use path on the north side of 14<sup>th</sup> Street and the west side of Dugdale Road providing local residents a safe and convenient access to Greenbelt Forest Preserve and the Robert McClory Bike Path.

As the part of the proposed improvements, LCDOT is requesting additional right-of-way on the west side of Dugdale Road and the northwest corner of the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> Street and Lewis Avenue and temporary easements along the north side of 14<sup>th</sup> Street within Greenbelt Forest Preserve.

Staff is seeking approval to continue discussions with LCDOT, and for authorization to negotiate an intergovernmental agreement.

**<u>REASON FOR REQUEST</u>**: District policy requires approval by relevant Standing Committees for negotiation of intergovernmental agreements.
