


Total Raised as of 3/20/2016: \$1,823,150

Planned Giving


On March 30, a second Natural Legacies planned giving e-newsletter was sent to 1,449 individual emails. This distribution represents nearly a threefold increase from our first e-newsletter sent to 499 individual emails.

Preservation Foundation Summer Tour 2016

Staff and volunteers will have a presence at up to 40 public events, farmer's markets and festivals from spring through fall, all across Lake County.

The goals of the Summer Tour are to raise public awareness of the Preservation Foundation and to acquire prospective donor contact information.

As a test, staff attended the Green Living Fair in Libertyville on Saturday, March 12. Of 159 total visitors to the Preservation Foundation booth, 60



completed information cards were received, in exchange for receiving a free packet of Common Milkweed seed. This represented a capture rate for "families" of nearly 100%. Three individuals made charitable contributions. With better signage and encouragement to make a gift, more gifts might have been secured.
