

Public Safety Monthly Report August 18, 2016- September 21, 2016

The Pay by Phone Application at the Dog Exercise Areas has collected \$6,000 in daily fees since its inception three months ago.

Ranger Police officers arrested two of the Felony Lane Gang car burglars from Florida at Buffalo Creek after they committed a burglary at Lakewood A and B lot. Officers located the proceeds of three earlier burglaries in their possession from Lakewood, Grayslake and unincorporated Lake County. Suspects also identified through video as the ones that committed the burglary at McDonald Woods a few days earlier.

Accidents

A District squad received damage from a large piece of a truck tire that flew up and struck the vehicle while on the Tri-State Tollway.

Alarms

Officers responded to a total of 7 activated alarms at Ryerson, Independence Grove, Brae Loch, and Prairie Stream.

Arrests

- Officers arrested a driver for expired plates and suspended driver's license at Lyon Woods.
- Officers arrested two subjects at Buffalo Creek for burglary to motor vehicle from Lakewood A and B lot and several other jurisdictions.
- Officers cited a person for damage and encroachment at Pine Dunes.
- Officers cited two people at Fort Sheridan for trying to force open the entry gate and entering the closed lakefront area.

Assist Other Agencies

- Officers assisted Lindenhurst PD with a missing suicidal individual at Miller and Beck Rd. Subject located and turned over to Lindenhurst.
- Officers assisted Lindenhurst PD in a search for a suicidal subject in the area of McDonald Woods. Officers located the person in the preserve and assisted him in getting treatment.
- Officers located a highly intoxicated person at Buffalo Creek. Rescue transported the person to the hospital.
- Officers assisted rescue with an injured juvenile at Oak Springs. Rescue turned juvenile over to parents.
- Officers assisted rescue on the Des Plaines River Trail and Kilbourne Road for an elderly person who had a dizzy spell and fell. Rescue transported the person.
- Officers assisted rescue twice at Lakewood with injured runners during the cross country meet.
- Officers assisted Grayslake PD with manpower searching for a bank robbery suspect.

Crime Reports

- Officers located damage to a comfort trailer at Greenbelt. Unknown persons tried to pry the door open.
- Officers took a burglary to motor vehicle report at Greenbelt Shelter B. The owner left their windows open and a purse on the front seat.
- Officers took a burglary to motor vehicle report at Cuba Marsh. Suspects broke the rear window and removed a purse from the seat.
- Officers took a burglary to motor vehicle report at McDonald Woods. Suspects broke the window and took a purse. Suspects identified in a video where a credit card had been used.

Service Calls

- Officers responded to 7 animal complaints this period at Prairie Wolf, Independence Grove, and Lakewood. Only one call involved a dog bite.
- Officers investigated 10 suspicious person or vehicle calls this period at Grant, Half Day, Rollins Savanna, Independence Grove, Van Patten, and Fourth Lake.
- Officers located two marijuana grows at Grassy Lake. All plants removed for destruction.
- Officers broke up juveniles fighting at Independence Grove. Juveniles turned over to their parents.
- Officers completed a delayed report of a patron breaking their leg at Fort Sheridan.

Encroachments

- Officers spoke with a neighbor of Grant Woods for parking a trailer on Preserve property. Vehicle removed by owner.
- Officer issued a warning to a landscaper for mowing and clearing and a citation for operating a vehicle on District property at Waukegan Savanna. The line is not clearly marked and a request for survey has been submitted.
- Officers investigated a clearing of District land at Pine Dunes. The owner had a crew clear an area to put up a fence. Owner of property cited for the damage.
