<u>Section 2: Auction of Equipment.</u> The Executive Director, or his designee, is hereby authorized to (i) cause the Equipment to be auctioned "as is," individually or in one or more lots, to the highest bidder and (ii) discard any Equipment for which no suitable bids are received.

<u>Section 3:</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
