**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the termination of the existing Farm License Agreement at Lake Marie Forest Preserve.

**STRATEGIC DIRECTIONS SUPPORTED:** Conservation; Organizational Sustainability

<u>FINANCIAL DATA</u>: The existing Lake Marie Farm License Agreement with The Arthur Brown Bushing Trust generated annual revenue of \$35,632.98 (157.32 acres at \$226.50/acre). It is anticipated that similar revenue will be generated from solicitation of new bids.

**BACKGROUND:** The farming program is conducted with local farmers to provide cost-effective, interim land use and management until the District is ready to convert farmland to other forest preserve purposes.


On January 1, 2016, The Arthur Brown Bushing Trust entered into a Farm License Agreement for the Lake Marie Forest Preserve for a term of four years (2016 through 2019). On October 4, 2017, the District received a letter from the Trust requesting termination of the License Agreement (effective December 31, 2017) citing an internal, unforeseen disagreement within the Trust whereby the Beneficiary of the Trust no longer considers this License Agreement in accord with the requirements of the Trust. The Trust is willing to pay 2017 license fees.

Based on staff's and counsel's review of the letter and the License Agreement, we believe that the Trust does not have a right to terminate. However, in light of the apparent internal disagreement within the Trust, staff believes that the District would be better off re-licensing the parcel to a more stable licensee. As such, staff recommends that the District agree to terminate the License Agreement, but only after all 2017 license fees have been paid in full.
