- ◉ **FREE:** supplies, snack, lunch, bus transportation



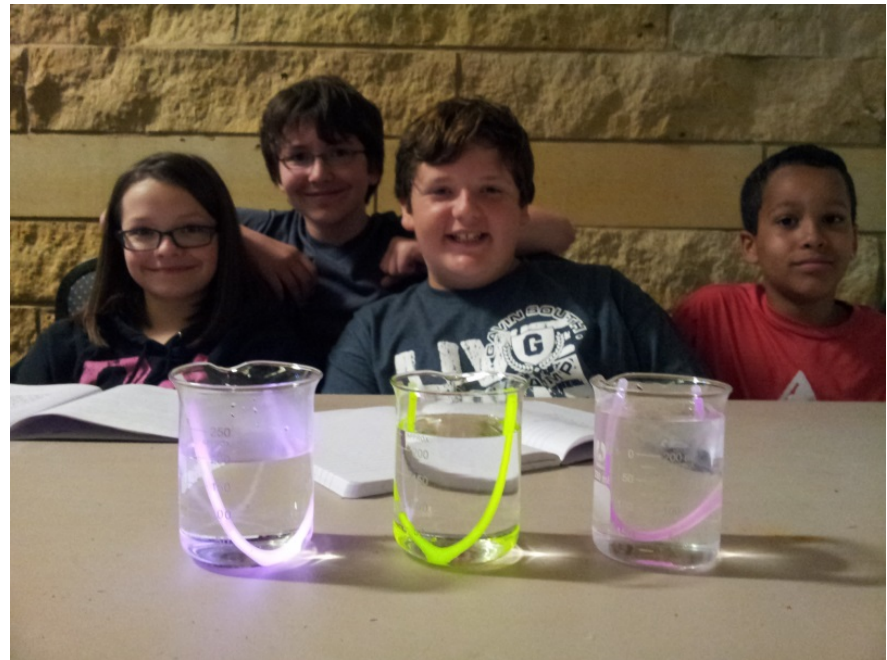
A Typical Day
