Phase I Invasive Plant Control at Cuba Marsh Forest Preserve

**RECOMMENDATION:** Recommend approval of a Resolution awarding a Contract for the Phase I Invasive Plant Control Project at Cuba Marsh Forest Preserve to Homer Tree Service, Inc., Lockport, Illinois in the Contract Price of \$258,475.00.

BACKGROUND: Cuba Marsh Forest Preserve is a 781-acre preserve consisting of large habitat blocks of prairie, wetland, fields, shrubland, and woodland communities. A wide diversity of plants and animals are found here, including several that are listed by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources as Species in Greatest Need of Conservation. Past habitat restoration efforts including the control of invasive species and controlled burning have improved the ecological health in many areas of the preserve. This contract is for the removal of invasive woody plants – primarily buckthorn and non-native crabapple – found within a 90-acre remnant oak woodland and adjacent prairie/shrubland. The project area is west of the CN railroad tracks and east of Lake Zurich Road on the western edge of the preserve.

The project was advertised on September 10, 2014 and three (3) bids were received. A summary of the bids received is listed below:

Staff recommends that Homer Tree Service, Inc. be awarded the contract as the lowest responsible bidder. Work is anticipated to begin December 15, 2014 and be completed by July 15, 2015.
