RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of a Resolution awarding a Contract for Invasive Plant Control at Middlefork Savanna Forest Preserve to Applied Ecological Services, Inc., Brodhead, Wisconsin in the Contract Price of \$49,445.00.

STRATEGIC DIRECTION SUPPORTED: Conservation

FINANCIAL DATA: The Middlefork Savanna project was estimated at \$46,000.00, with an actual cost of \$49,445.00 and will be charged to two accounts: \$40,000.00 to the Habitat Restoration account (20104100-803200-60004) and \$9,445.00 to the Farmland Management Fund (28644000-705100-62803).

BACKGROUND: Invasive plant management is the most time-consuming task faced by District crews, and is a significant challenge to habitat conservation. Management of invasive plants is necessary to improve and conserve habitat quality and species diversity on District properties throughout Lake County. In order to accomplish this work, the District hires contractors to augment the District's work. The Middlefork Savanna Project will provide season-long control of invasive plants at Middlefork Savanna.

The project was advertised on January 11, 2019 and seven bids were received. A summary of the bids received is listed below:

Staff recommends that Applied Ecological Services, Inc. be awarded the contract as the lowest responsible bidder. Work is anticipated to begin April 1, 2019. Work will be completed by December 31, 2019.

As part of this bid process a smaller project was included at Grant Woods. A low bid of \$13,000.00 was submitted by Tallgrass Restoration. As this bid was well below the \$25,000.00 threshold requiring Board approval, staff awarded the contract as provided in the District's Purchasing Policies.
