RECOMMENDATION: Approve the award of two Farm Licenses at Lake Marie and Ray Lake Forest Preserves to the highest qualified bidders.

STRATEGIC DIRECTIONS SUPPORTED: Conservation; Organizational Sustainability

FINANCIAL DATA: Awarding the licenses will generate \$24,106.26 annually and will be credited to the Farmland Management Fund (28642500-403000). Revenue generated from this land in 2018 was \$50,482.26.

BACKGROUND: The farming program of the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") licenses certain lands acquired by the District for agricultural use to provide cost-effective, interim land use and management until the District is ready to convert farmland to other forest preserve purposes. Bradley Cockrum was the former Licensee for these farm parcels; however, Mr. Cockrum contacted the District in late March to request a termination of these agreements due to financial hardship. The license agreements were terminated on April 1, 2019, after review and approval by the Operations Committee.

The farm licenses were advertised in the News-Sun and bid packages were available on the District's website. The licenses were advertised for a 1-year term effective as of the date of license award. Two potential Licensees submitted bids. The highest qualified bidders for the parcels are noted below:




