RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of a Resolution awarding Contracts for the Native Seed Purchase 2020 for Multiple Preserves to Shooting Star Native Seeds, Spring Grove, Minnesota, in the Contract Price of $\$ 56,436.61$ and to Genesis Nursery, Inc., Tampico, Illinois, in the Contract Price of $\$ 68,240.15$.

## STRATEGIC DIRECTION SUPPORTED: Conservation

FINANCIAL DATA: The native seed supply for the various projects was either approved as part of the adopted FY 2020 budget or will be carried over from the FY2019 budget as part of an ongoing project. The cost of purchase and delivery of native seed for the various projects was estimated at $\$ 212,000.00$. The actual cost is $\$ 125,611.48$. Of the actual cost, the following accounts and funds will be charged for the various projects:

The bids under $\$ 25,000.00$ that do not require Committee and Board approval total $\$ 934.72$, and combined with the contract that would be approved by the attached resolution, total \$125,611.48.

BACKGROUND: The District will be installing native seed in the fall 2020 at Van Patten Woods, Middlefork Savanna, Captain Daniel Wright Woods, MacArthur Woods, Grant Woods, Fourth Lake, Grassy Lake and Wadsworth Savanna Forest Preserves as part of ongoing ecological restoration efforts. Additionally, a small amount of seed will be purchased to support in-house natural resource management projects and volunteer efforts following various habitat restoration efforts. Seed installation will occur across more than 345 acres.

The project was advertised on January 13, 2020 and four bids were received. A summary of the lowest bids received and recommended for approval is listed below:

Materials were bid on a unit price per species. Staff recommends that the bid submitted by Applied Ecological Services be found not responsive because, for each of the species on which it attempted to bid, it failed to provide one or more of the following required information: Total Quantity Available, Unit Price, and Extension Price. Staff has awarded a contract to Cardno, Inc. whose total bid is less than $\$ 25,000.00$.

Staff recommends that Shooting Star Native Seeds and Genesis Nursery Inc. each be awarded a contract as the lowest responsible bidder for the species for which it was the low bidder. Each submitted total low bids greater than $\$ 25,000.00$, thus requiring Committee recommendation and Board approval of the contracts for those bids. Work is anticipated to begin fall 2020 and be completed by winter 2020/2021.

WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") has advertised in The News Sun for sealed bids to purchase native seed for habitat restoration projects at multiple forest preserves (the "Products"); and

WHEREAS, all sealed bids were received and opened by the District at its General Offices, 1899 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois, on January 29, 2020, at 11:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the District's staff, the Purchasing Manager, the Director of Natural Resources; the Operations Committee and the Finance Committee have reviewed the bids identified on Exhibit A and recommend that the Board of Commissioners find (i) Shooting Star Native Seeds to be the lowest responsible bidder with respect to the bids that it submitted and which are listed on Exhibit A (the "Shooting Star Native Seeds Bids"); and (ii) Genesis Nursery, Inc. to be the lowest responsible bidder with respect to the bids that it submitted and which are listed on Exhibit A (the "Genesis Nursery, Inc. Bids") and award contracts for the Products to these bidders consistent therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that the bids submitted by Applied Ecological Services, Inc. is not a responsive bid; and

The Genesis Nursery, Inc. Bids in the total amount of $\$ 68,240.15$ (the "Genesis Nursery, Inc. Contract Price") are hereby accepted and a contract for Products in the amount of the Genesis Nursery, Inc. Contract Price is hereby awarded to Genesis Nursery, Inc. (the "Genesis Nursery, Inc. Contract") (collectively, the Shooting Star Native Seeds Contract, and the Genesis Nursery, Inc. Contract are the "Contracts").

Section 4: Execution of Contracts. The Executive Director of the District is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Contracts for the Products in the amounts of the Shooting Star Native Seeds Contract Price, and the Genesis Nursery, Inc. Contract Price.

Section 5: Payments. The Treasurer shall make payments under the Contracts only pursuant to and in accordance with the Contracts' terms.

Section 6: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
