SUBJECT: Phase II Engineering Services for the Lyons Woods-Waukegan Savanna Trail Connection

RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of a Resolution awarding a Contract for Phase II Engineering Services for the Lyons Woods-Waukegan Savanna Trail Connection to Gewalt-Hamilton Associates, Inc., Vernon Hills, Illinois, in the Contract Price of \$198,344.00.

BACKGROUND: The Lake County Forest Preserve Board of Commissioners approved a Phase I engineering contract for Gewalt Hamilton and Associates October 6, 2014. The Phase II Engineering Services contract will complete the trail design and bidding documents for the Lyons Woods-Waukegan Savanna Trail Connection. In February 2015 a grant application was submitted under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program administered through the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT). Phase II engineering services are required by IDOT to prepare the project for federal funding assistance.

Phase II engineering services will include land surveying, data collection, permitting and agency coordination, design, engineering, and preparation of bidding and contract documents. This project includes the extension of approximately 2 miles of 10-foot-wide asphalt trail from the existing trail system within the Lyons Woods Forest Preserve, which currently ends at the Robert McClory Bike Path, to the west, crossing both Lewis Avenue and McAree Road to Green Bay Road and ultimately creating a link to the Waukegan Savanna Forest Preserve. The trail will extend into two Waukegan Park District sites: Bevier Park and Callahan Park. The project proposes a 14-ft wide pedestrian bridge in Bevier Park to cross the Waukegan River.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION: Committee approval is required in accordance with District policy.

FINANCIAL DATA: This project was approved as part of the adopted FY 2015/2016 Capital Improvement Plan in the amount of \$200,000.00. This portion of the project was estimated at \$200,000.00. The actual cost of \$198,344.00 will be charged to account 35634100-803200-63010.

A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR PHASE II ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE LYONS WOODS-WAUKEGAN SAVANNA TRAIL CONNECTION

WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") desires to retain a firm to perform engineering services that include land surveying, data collection, permitting and agency coordination, design, engineering, and preparation of bidding and contract documents to construct the Lyons Woods-Waukegan Savanna Trail Connection (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, the Director of Planning and Land Preservation and the Purchasing Manager have determined that the Services require personal confidence; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Manager has solicited a proposal for the Services; and

WHEREAS, the District's staff, the Purchasing Manager, the Director of Planning and Land Preservation, the Planning and Restoration Committee, and the Finance and Administrative Committee have reviewed the proposal and recommend that the Board of Commissioners (i) find that the proposal submitted by Gewalt-Hamilton Associates, Inc., be determined to be the proposal that is most advantageous to the District; and (ii) award a contract for the Services to Gewalt-Hamilton Associates, Inc. (the "Contract"), in the amount of \$198,344.00 (the "Contract Price"); and

WHEREAS, the District has a satisfactory relationship with Gewalt-Hamilton Associates, Inc., for engineering services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that the proposal for the Services submitted by Gewalt-Hamilton Associates, Inc., is the proposal that is most advantageous to the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois **THAT**:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are incorporated as a part of this Resolution by this reference.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Award of Contract</u>. A Contract for the Services in the amount of the Contract Price is hereby awarded to Gewalt-Hamilton Associates, Inc.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Execution of Contract</u>. The Executive Director of the District is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Contract for the Services in the amount of the Contract Price.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Payments</u>. The Treasurer shall make payments under the Contract only pursuant to and in accordance with the Contract terms.

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
